## Additional Instructions:

- » No recent hospitalizations within 6 weeks due to respiratory infection.
- » Continue to take all your other medicine as you usually do.
- » No respiratory infection (cold) within 6 weeks.
- » Refrain from smoking/vaping and vigorous exercise the day of your test.
- » No ingestions of cola drinks, Mountain Dew, Coke, Pepsi, Mello-Yello, etc., coffee, tea, chocolate and other agents containing caffeine for 6 hours.

**About your procedure:** A Methacholine Challenge Study cannot be scheduled in conjunction with any other pulmonary test.

**How to find us:** When you arrive at Altru Hospital, you must register for your procedure in Admitting located in the Main Entrance area of the hospital.

Contraindications: No eye surgery for 6 weeks prior to testing

No Myocardial Infarction or stroke in the last 3 months

Uncontrolled Hypertension Known Aortic Aneurism

Methacholine challenge studies have been scheduled for you by your doctor to identify airway irritability. This may be useful in evaluating symptoms suggestive of asthma. The technique may also be used to document bronchial hypersensitivity to specific work-related material.

This test consists of having you breathe easily and forcefully. The way you breathe will be explained more completely to you by the technician.

You will be asked to perform the same breathing maneuver several times, until a stable baseline is established.

You will then be given 5 inhalations of a low dose of Methacholine, following by the same breathing maneuver.

Doses of Methacholine are increased and breathing maneuvers repeated until a positive response is obtained or the maximum dose is reached.

There is no pain involved during the test.

If this test is positive you will be given a medication in mist form to dilate your airways. This medicine will return your breathing back to normal. Then you will be asked to repeat the breathing test.

This test will take a total of 1 to 1 1/2 hours.

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Please check in at the Registration Desk at Altru Hospital 10 minutes before your appointment.
