» Ninety percent of people whose colorectal cancer is found at an early stage are alive five years after diagnosis.

Prevention

» During a colonoscopy, the provider can remove precancerous polyps before they turn into cancer.

No-Cost Colonoscopy Eligibility Guidelines

- » You are age 50 through 75.
- » You meet income guidelines below (income is self-reported - no forms required).

Number of People in Household	Yearly Income
1	\$35,640
2	\$48,060
3	\$60,480
4	\$72,900

- » You are uninsured or underinsured.
- » You have never been screened or are past due for colorectal screening.
- » You are a North Dakota or Minnesota resident.
