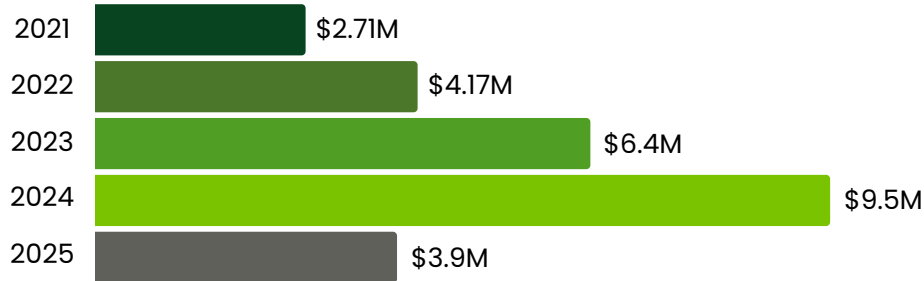

This momentum is visible all around us, from expanding healthy living efforts through the Blue Zones Project, to increasing access to first-aid and disaster management support with the Mobile Health Hub, to enhancing ultrasound care through a major grant project. 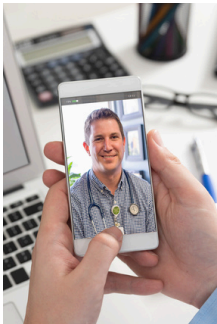


Your Generosity in Action



Powering Possibilities

The 2025 Altru Cancer Center Golf Tournament expanded to two courses for the first time, raising over \$128,000 to support cancer patients and vital programs. That momentum continued with the 2025 Altru Gala, which raised more than \$569,000—including two \$100,000 match gifts—to expand the Altru Behavioral Health Center.



Bringing Care to You

In partnership with the American Heart Association, Altru Foundation has helped streamline telehealth exam rooms through standardized equipment, better resources, staff education, and clear workflows. In recognition, Altru was selected as one of only five organizations nationwide for an in-person AHA site visit, including video production and staff interviews. The video will be featured on the AHA website, showcasing Altru's leadership and innovation in telehealth.



Expanding Support

2025 marked a milestone for behavioral healthcare as Altru opened the newly consolidated Behavioral Health Center and broke ground on a major expansion. The project will add 24 inpatient beds, a "connector" to the emergency room, an indoor recreation space, and expanded programming. Thanks to support from the State of North Dakota, Otto Bremer Trust, our generous Gala givers and individual donors, philanthropy is positively impacting the growing behavioral health needs of our region.

Rising to the Occasion

Altru's Wellness Pantry is available to our patients who screen positively for food insecurity. In partnership with Great Plains Food Bank, this program provides patients and their families with food during difficult financial times. This program has been leaned on heavily—especially in 2025—as we distributed more than 300 baskets—11,662 pounds of food—which supported the nutritional needs of nearly 900 people. Generous community partners, including Hugo's, played an important role in making this support possible.
